Lesson 19: Three Little Pigs **Lesson 19 Overview:** In Lesson 19, children will order the events of a story in a sequence and plan their final projects using a graphic organizer.

I. Warm Up: Three Little Pigs

• Read the book *The Three Little Pigs* together as a class.

II. Opening Tech Circle: Order of Events

- Review the order of events in the story *The Three Little Pigs,* showing examples from the book.
- Pick three scenes to discuss and ask children where they belong in the story the beginning, middle, or end. Have children place the events in order. Ask what would happen if we rearranged the story so the middle scene was first, and first scene was last.

III. Word Time: Connecting Characters to Action & Making Our Plan

- Explain to children that they will now begin a project programming our own class play of the Three Little Pigs!
- In groups, children will use the graphic organizer in their design journal write their story script and plan their program.

IV. Closing Tech Circle: 2 Stars and a Wish

• Have groups share their project plans using the 2 Stars and a Wish feedback prompt. Stars are two things that went well, and a Wish is one thing you want to do better or change next time you work on your project
